Keeping children safe is a huge responsibility. The Kinderprint Child Identification Kit program helps police identify lost children and reunite them with their parent or guardian.

The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children estimates that over 800,000 children are lost, abducted, abandoned or run away in the United States each year. These kits can provide vital pieces of identifying information in the search for these children.

The kit contains complete instructions and supplies to collect a child's fingerprints, personal information (such as name, address, sex, height, weight, photo), and "Child Safety Tips". These would help the police identify a lost child. Police services worldwide recommend that families hold on to these kits and keep the information up-to-date as their children grow.

|----------------------|-----------------|
| 2 c. sugar           | 4 Tbsp. Cocoa   |
| 1/2 c. butter        | 3 c. quick oats |
| 1/2 c. milk          | 1 tsp. vanilla  |
| 1/2 c. peanut butter |                 |

1. Put sugar, butter and milk in heavy sauce pan.
2. Bring to a boil and boil for 1 minute.
3. Remove from heat.
4. Stir in peanut butter.
5. Add oatmeal, vanilla and cocoa.
6. Drop from teaspoon onto wax paper.
7. Let cool.
8. Eat!!
